Dr. Guy French is a Senior Engineering Research Psychologist with the 711th Human Performance Wing's Airman Systems Directorate of the Air Force Research Laboratory at Wright-Patterson AFB OH. His current work is the exploration of human interaction with automation and autonomous systems. The primary focus of his work is the design and development of multi-UAV command and control interfaces.

Prior to his work in unmanned systems, he managed several AFRL dual-use research and development programs to prototype and flight test synthetic and enhanced vision systems for the Air Force operational environment. He also worked closely with NASA Langley Research Center to develop and test pilot vehicle interface concepts for reduced visibility operations.

He received his doctorate in Educational Psychology (Psychometrics) from the University of Texas at Austin in 1998.
